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The Board of County Commissioners met in special session in the County Commissioners' Room. Present were Paul McCartney and Arthur Kuhlmann, Commissioners. Also present was Ashley Maxwell, Deputy Clerk, Darrell Shellito, Road & Bridge Supervisor, Ted Mogan, Rock Foreman, Ron Hayes, Road & Bridge Employee and Mel Holle, Landoll Corporation.

Commissioners discussed the need for a trailer to haul the rock grinder. Holle presented the Commissioners with an estimate of \$49,650.24 for a 24' well trailer. Shellito, Mogan, and Hayes discussed the need for an additional 2' to meet the needs of the rock grinder. Holle advised the Commissioners he would take the exact specs of the rock grinder back to his office and use the computer software to aid in determining the footage needed. Holle also visited with Hayes about additional dimensions of the tractor itself. Holle agreed to stop by the barn to get measurements.


Shellito left the meeting.


As there was no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
