

The County Commissioners met in regular session on September 13, 2010 in the County Commissioners' Room. Present were Arthur Kuhlmann, Joe Kingsbury and Paul McCartney, Commissioners. Also present was Clerk, Sharon Wolters.

Commissioners approved the minutes from the September 07, 2010 meeting.

Commissioners reviewed and approved the agenda.

Commission chairman signed the Treasurer's Daily Statement envelopes.

Commissioners reviewed, initialed and approved payroll #19 for \$76934.14.

Ted Mogan, Dennis Peterson and Darrell Shellito, Road Department, joined the meeting and discussed the following:

1. Kuhlmann discussed 275 Road between J & K Roads. Kuhlmann indicated that there may need to be baracades at this location.
2. Kuhlmann discussed maintenance in Harvey Township. Kuhlmann indicated that there needs to be bridge repair or a tube at 210 Road between L & M Roads.
3. Kingsbury asked about the bridge by Steve St. Clair's. Shellito indicated that FEMA will consider it as a mitigation project.
4. McCartney discussed widening 90 Road between S & V Roads.
5. Kuhlmann discussed purchasing an excavator for the county road department.
6. Shellito discussed purchasing a trailer for the rock grinder. Shellito agreed to contact the owner of a trailer that he located and report to the commissioners. Commissioners reviewed the budget information for the Road Department.
7. Commissioners reviewed the County Certification for the CBDG Project Bids.
8. Kingsbury asked Peterson about training the bridge crew on the crane. Peterson indicated that he has not been able to train anyone because they have been busy replacing so many tubes and repairing bridges after the flooding. He indicated that they will train during winter months when they are unable to work outside.

A motion was made by A. Kuhlmann and seconded by J. Kingsbury to close the west one half mile on 230 Road between sections 22 & 27 in Township 4 South and Range 12 West. Motion carried unanimously.

Carroll Pletcher joined the meeting and asked about closing ½ mile of the road located on 230 Road between section 22 and 27 of Crystal Plains. Commissioners indicated that they have already officially made a motion and passed it to close the west ½ mile of the road. Pletcher left the meeting.

Patrick Eates, EMS Director, joined the meeting and discussed the following:

1. Kuhlmann inquired about dispatch for a recent ambulance call. Eates suggested that the commissioners check with dispatch for details. He also indicated that it was a cell phone call which was originally received by Rooks County and believed that this played a part in directions given to EMS.
2. Eates reported that he has ordered the tires from Rietzke LLC.
3. Eates reviewed the statistical report for August. EMS received 34 calls in August.
4. Eates reported that he may be gone for the next commissioners meeting.

Al Gaines, Landfill Supervisor, discussed the following:

1. Gaines discussed the most recent KWORCC review.
2. Gaines discussed the road at the landfill. Gaines reported that they are continuing to haul rock.
3. Gaines agreed to report back to the commissioners after his next doctor's appointment.

Casey Frasier, Foley Implement, joined the meeting and presented a contract for the rock grinder. Commissioners accepted and signed the contract to purchase the rock grinder.


Commissioners received a road maintenance request for the intersection of 40 and E Roads intersection which has pooled water in the intersection. Commissioners advised Shellito of the location.

As there was no further business, the meeting was adjourned.


